SAFETY FIRST!

Collections

Public street collections (which includes going from business to business) must have a license. You also need to obtain permission from the owner or manager when a collection takes place on private property, such as a public house. Licenses can be obtained from the council at http://www.calderdale.

gov.uk/business/licenses/streetcollections/index.html

Donations

The person that is collecting donations should be someone that you know and trust. If children are collecting donations make sure that they are supervised at all times. Please let us know where the collection will take place.

Licenses

You will need a license if you are planning to sell alcoholic drinks outside of a licenced venue. Please check with us or with your local council if you are in any doubts.

Lotteries and Raffles

Rules change depending on the size of your event. If you hold a raffle at your work place, club or your house there is no need to obtain a license. We have Overgate raffle tickets that we can supply to you. For larger raffles please contact your local council/authority to check. Overgate Hospice has its own lottery and forms are available from the fundraising department.

We want to you to have as much fun as possible at your event but please ensure you have plans in place for the safety of your participants. LET'S GET STARTED!

Now you have decided on your event you have a few more decisions to make:

Date & Venue

Once you know what you're doing, find the right place and time for it. Check local calendars to make sure there are no big clashes and be honest with your venue about what your event entails to avoid any confusion from the start.

Support

We're here to support you through your event but it's a good idea to ask friends. family and colleagues for help too.

Contacts

Make sure you keep a list of contacts that have helped you through your event so you can thank them. Let us know if you need some Overgate thank you cards!

Fundraising

Find as many ways possible to raise funds at your event: raffles, auctions, games or auizzes.

Budaet

Make sure you know what your budget is before you start; it makes it easier to allocate costs. Also set yourself a fundraising target. People are more likely to donate if they see you're within reach of your target.

Posters

Make a poster for your event. We can help with this, please use our logo on any posters and we will happily supply it to you. We are a registered charity, our number is 511619, please use our number on any of your communication.

giftaid it Make sure vou take some Gift Aid forms and tell people about Gift Aid,

GETINVOLVED

for every £1 donated to us we can claim 25p from the government if the sponsor pays tax!

Match Funding

Ask your employer if they provide Matched Giving. This means that if your employer is signed up to Match Giving they match up your fundraising pound for pound up to a certain amount.

If in doubt please let us know!

We're here to help, and whilst we may not always be able to attend your event we can support you in the lead up to it, so if there's something you are stuck with, drop us a line or give us a call!

PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS

Sponsor Forms

We can provide you with some Hospice Heroes sponsor forms. We can send these on email or we can pop them in the post.

Posters

We have some posters with our logo on. You can download one from our website. If you'd prefer to have a poster designed for your event we can help with that too!

Letters of support

You may want to go out into the community and ask for support from local businesses. We can offer a letter of support on headed paper so the business and places you go to know that we are aware of your fundraising.

We have t-shirts, collecting tubs, buckets and balloons to help at your events too.

We can offer Gift Aid declaration forms or donation envelopes so that we can claim Gift Aid, which is an extra 25p for every £1 donated, please just ask!

We always have other promotional materials about other events and challenges that we advertise, so if you could take any leaflets or posters about these then that would help us greatly.





Advertise your event, write to the local press and use social media sites such as Twitter, Facebook and Instagram to advertise for free. Ask the fundraising team for help with press releases or printing posters and other marketing material.

Ask friends and family to help you out, use their contacts and places of work to hand out posters and flyers, or ask if you can give them a sponsor form!

As well as using Facebook to advertise your event, set up an event on Facebook and invite all your friends, ask them to share on their pages too. Link it to our page and we can help you advertise!



JustGiving



Use JustGiving or Virgin Money Giving to set up an online sponsor page. These sites are really trustworthy and the organisations have a lot of experience in helping charities make the most of their money. Not only do you not need to go around collecting sponsor money but the companies claim our Gift Aid for us, which helps us greatly! Don't forget to set a closing date for the page.
